US Department of Labor awards more than \$130M in grants to support Registered Apprenticeship programs; increase employment opportunities

The U.S. Department of Labor today announced the award of more than \$130 million in grants to develop, modernize and diversify Registered Apprenticeship Programs in 15 states and to establish Registered Apprenticeship Technical Assistance Centers of Excellence in three states and Washington, D.C., to provide technical expertise and services and accelerate the expansion of Registered Apprenticeship programs. The department's Employment and Training Administration awarded more than \$99 million in State Apprenticeship Expansion, Equity and Innovation grants – ranging from \$2 million to \$10 million – to bolster states' efforts to expand programming and inclusive recruitment strategies to attract a diverse workforce. The awards include more than \$85 million for states that demonstrated a commitment to increase their diversity, equity and inclusion efforts. These grants also aim to develop partnerships with new industries and non-traditional occupations, including industry sectors hardest hit by the pandemic, and align Registered Apprenticeships with other work-based learning opportunities within state education and workforce systems

6 things to know about virtual internships post-COVID District Administrator

Virtual internships will outlast COVID because they give businesses access to a much broader pool of candidates, particularly underrepresented students, says one provider. To get a handle on the climate for internships post-COVID, District Administration spoke with Kate Haydon, the director of academy development at NAF, a national nonprofit that partners with employers and with districts to create CTE-based "schools within schools." 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Fewer working-age people may slow economy. Will it lift pay? Associated Press

As America's job market rebounds this summer and the need for workers intensifies, employers won't likely have a chance to relax anytime soon. Worker shortages will likely persist for years after the fast-reopening economy shakes off its growing pains. Consider that the number of working age people did something last year it had never done in the nation's history: It shrank. Estimates from the Census Bureau showed that the U.S. population ages 16 through 64 fell 0.1% in 2020 — a scant drop but the first decline of any kind after decades of steady increases. It reflected a sharp fall in immigration, the retirements of the vast baby boom generation and a slowing birth rate. The size of the 16-64 age group was also diminished last year by thousands of deaths from the coronavirus.
